- Tree Preservation Order 337 was made on 30th September 2004 and confirmed on the 12th November 2004.
- 2. The neighbouring property owner applied to fell the tree on the grounds that it was causing damage to his property.
- The application to fell the tree was refused.
- 4. The refusal was upheld on appeal due to insufficient evidence being produced by the applicant.
- The neighbours Insurance Company has now made a claim under the Town and Country. Planning Act 1990 for compensation for damages.
- On review of the whole matter it appears that the order was confirmed under delegated powers as an unopposed order, whereas there was a valid objection to the order.
- In the circumstances it is considered expedient to revoke the order.
