Children will only be allowed in restricted areas and where appropriate with adults e.g. for a meal

Staff require customers to prove their age on request.

There is external security lighting

Drugs are not permitted on the premises.

Late admission to premises is restricted to an appropriate time

Drunken people are not permitted on the premises

Customers are encouraged to leave premises quietly

Taxi telephone numbers are supplied for use by customers

Open containers may not be taken from the premises

Emergency routes are indicated

Health and safety regulations are complied with.

Fire points are clearly indicated with easy access to fire fighting equipment.

Safety equipment is regularly checked

New staff are made aware of company policies on emergency routes and fire safety equipment and its use

The capacity of the premises is approximately 85-90 including restaurant and bar sitting and standing areas. The garden can accommodate up to 50 customers.

All electrical equipment - computers etc are switched off when not in use

There is a non-smoking restaurant area - customers may smoke in other areas of the premises

There are smoke alarms and emergency exit signage in appropriate locations - see plan.

Emergency exits are kept clear at all time

Fire exit door has emergency bar

Exits are signed and illuminated

Waste is removed by specialist contractors

Staff training includes the Licensing Objectives



**b) The prevention of crime and disorder**

- Underage drinking is not permitted on the premises
  - Premises supervised at all times by management and staff
  - Proof of age required on demand
  - Outside lighting is used
  - Open containers may not be taken from the premises
  - Drunken behaving not permitted
  - Drunk customers are not served
  - Drugs are not permitted on the premises
  - Aggressive or anti-social behaviour are not permitted
  - Capacities are limited to an appropriate level for a particular event
  - A burgular alarm system is installed
  - Taxi numbers are available for customers

**c) Public safety**

- Fire safety procedures are employed
- Emergency routes are indicated
- Fire fighting equipment is is indicated and easily accessible
- Safety equipent ins inspected and maintained
- Staff are trained in emergency procedures
- Capacity is limited to an appropriate level for a particular event
- Appropriate health and safety guidelines are complied with
- An approved first aid kit is used on the premises

**d) The prevention of public nuisance**

- Taxi numbers are available for customer use
- Customers are encouraged to leave premises quietly
- Restaurant, bar, general and litter waste is removed from the premises by specialist contractor
- Capacities limited as stated above.
- Last admission time used on appropriate occassions
- Alcohol may be confiscated at any time where appropriate

- Children are only allowed in designated areas
- Children must be accompanied by a responsible adult
- Proof of age is required on demand
- Children are not permitted where adult entertainment is taking place
- Children are not allowd to play AWP machines
