6. Project summary:

The grant is for Boules (Petanque) equipment for a new club based in Ashley, Box. The Club is independent with its own constitution and the equipment will be owned by the club and last for five years. The club started in January 2013 and has some 36 members. This application is for equipment to enable full start up and playing socially and in local leagues and competitions in the area, particularly focusing on increasing playing membership. The club is also funding materials and through time input by members the extension of the playing surface (piste)and upgrading of facilities. Our resources are therefore fully stretched, limiting the access that we can give to a popular sport that gathers the local community together and overcomes social isolation particularly in the older age groups and improving health

We are a start up Community Group - Box Parish council, Parish Plan (to support) The age profile of the club is currently high - the project overcomes social isolation encouraging individuals (often on their own) to get out and socialise, take part in a healthy activity and to improve health and general well being - Corsham area Board priority-Health, social care and recreation. The equipment will enable us to extend our membership (target 80 people by 2015)increase the number of games being played and give greater access to local leagues and competitions. We intend to hold open days to encourage increased membership and use of the facilities and widen the age profile in both directions. Such facilities in Ashley in Box are non-existent, so the equipment will enable and accelerate a greater community adherence and coming together

14. How will you monitor this?

The Aim and Purpose of the Club as set down in our constitution is - to organise and provide opportunities for the members to learn about, practice and become involved in all aspects of the sport of Petanque (sometimes referred to as Boules) and additionally, the club will aim to promote the sport within the local community and wider and to establish and maintain active contact with other organisations of similar interest. We will monitor the success of this through our annual plans with quantified targets for increasing members, training events, competitions (Internal & external)and activities of the club generally. We will keep actual numbers against these targets and improve or intervene as necessary so that they are achieved

15. If your project will continue after the Wiltshire Council funding runs out, how will you continue to fund it?

The grant application is for start up equipment which will last for 5 years. Once the club is established and with the related work of extending the piste and facilities (not part of this application but clearly related to it) the club will become self funding through membership and fund raising etc. If the grant application is unsuccessful then start up will be considerably slower and the range of activities we could offer would be reduced and the impact on social isolation, health, recreation and community togetherness significantly reduced

16. Is there anything else you think we should know about the project?

We intend extending the current piste area by 2m to comply with current competition and H&S requirements and increasing the number of lanes by 2 (50% increase) with associated fencing, allowing us to cater for more members, training and competitions. We are looking to increase playing times in the evening and some basic refurbishment (at this time) of an adjacent building to use as a small club house, store and gathering facility. The vast majority of this work will be done by members but there is a materials cost that we cannot avoid. The materials cost is estimated at £1,800. This work is likely to be done in spring 2014.
