Cricklade and Purton Councils have joined forces to share a Dog Awareness Week, 7<sup>th</sup> to 14<sup>th</sup> February 2015. The campaign is to encourage everyone who owns a dog to clear up after it. The campaign will highlight the dangers of dog mess as well as include a short story competition "There's no such thing as a dog poo fairy" and a school's word search quiz. The campaign is being supported from funds from the Area Board, leading on from the work undertaken by the Dog Fouling Task Group.

The Neighbourhood Planning Working Party recently issued a second stage of consultation, with specific questions on housing, and a healthy number responses (350+) were received. The information is now being analysed and the group will be issuing a report on its findings in due course. The group continues to meet regularly and members of the public who wish to take an interest are able to attend the meetings.

- Tesco has announced the withdrawal of their planning application for a store in the neighbouring parish of Lydiard Tregoze. Planning applications for 320 homes and a retail store are still being considered by Wiltshire Council.
- The Christmas Lights and Shopping Event 2014 was extremely successful and well attended.
- Gabriela Stanciu and David Wilson of Network Rail made a presentation to Royal Wootton Bassett Councillors at a meeting in December 2014 on the planned bridge closures in the Royal Wootton Bassett area to allow for the electrification of the Great Western Railway line.
