



COVID disease is an infection caused by a coronavirus. Long COVID is a term to describe the effects of COVID-19 that continue for weeks or months beyond the initial illness. The health watchdog NICE defines long COVID as lasting for more than 12 weeks, although some other people consider symptoms that last more than eight weeks to be long COVID.









Two hour urgent community response

- Fall (with no signs of serious injury)
- Decompensation of frailty
- Reduced function/deconditioning/
 reduced mobility
- Palliative/ end of life crisis support
- Urgent equipment provision to support a person experiencing a crisis/ at risk of hospital admission
- Confusion/ delirium
- Urgent catheter care
- Urgent support for diabetes
- Unpaid carer breakdown which, if not resolved, will result in a healthcare crisis for the person they care for


