Officers from the Neighbourhood Policing Team have been completing speed checks today in numerous locations including Burbage, Upavon and Rushall.

- Speeding

Road users who commit one of the Fatal Five offences are far more likely to be involved in a fatal collision than those who do not.

People are dying on our roads as a result of motorists' poor driving, reckless decisions and momentary lapses in concentration.

Fatal collisions are heart-breaking – for the family, for the community, and for the responding emergency services staff who have to witness the tragedy and subsequent aftermath and we've seen too many this year already.

Stopping any more deaths from occurring as a result of something unnecessary and totally avoidable is a top priority for us.

Across the Summer, our Community Policing Teams, along with speed enforcement officers and the Roads Policing Unit will be making sure motorists are being safe and driving smart.

54 drivers will be offered a speed awareness course


7 driver will be given £100 fine and receive 3 penalty points

Performance – 12 Months to July 2023

Force

- Wiltshire Police recorded crime reports a YoY increase of 0.1% in the 12 months to July 2023 and continues to have one of the lowest crime rates in the country per 1,000 population.
- Wiltshire Police has seen a 0.2% decrease in violence without injury crimes in the 12 months to July 2023.
- In July 2023, we received:
 - 10,901 '999' calls, which we answered within 12 seconds on average;
 - 16,318 '101' calls, which we answered within 1 minute 17 seconds on average;
 - 8,784 CRIB calls, which we answered within 14 minutes 8 seconds on average.
- In July 2023, we also attended 1,724 emergency incidents within 11 minutes and 11 seconds on average.

Stop and Search information for Devizes CPT

During the 12 months leading to June 2023, 131 stop and searches were conducted in the Devizes area of which 51.39% related to a search for controlled drugs.

During 84% of these searches, no object was found. In 16% of cases, an object was found. Of these cases 81.7% resulted in a no further action disposal; 13% resulted in police action being taken; 6.9% resulted in an arrest.

Of the stop and search subjects who defined their ethnicity:

- White 98 stop and searches
- Mixed 6 stop and searches

Data is reporting increases in Transgender and Sexual Orientation related hate which follows National trends.


Data from the victim satisfaction survey reports that Hate Crime victims have an 84.5% overall satisfaction rate with the service they receive from Wiltshire Police.



Crime levels remain stable and in line with annual demand.


Violence remains highest level of offending however includes private space violence.

- Neighbourhood officers will also conduct further drop in sessions to offer crime prevention advice linking in with the Bobby Van Charity.

	Priority	Update
	Thefts/Rural Crime	During the last 2 months, a spike in local thefts from vehicles and thefts from outbuildings has been identified. Work will now focus on both investigation of offences, and increasing 'crime prevention' advice to residents through drop in sessions and engagement opportunities
Lage ZZ	Speeding	In feedback to resident concerns, the Neighbourhood Team have conducted multiple speeding checks across the Marlborough sector with a range of drivers given words of advice, driver improvement courses or summonsed to court. These will be continue and are publicised on social media
	Increase In police visibility	A core current priority is to increase police visibility within the community, through both physical and online presence. There has been a real drive and significant focus on high visibility policing in rural villages. Over the last 3 month period response and neighbourhood officers have recorded nearly 100 high visibility patrols in rural villages, including engaging with shops/premises and community events. This will continue
