SPEED LIMIT REVIEW C AND UC ROADS C9, C32, C42 AND C155

Purpose of Report

To consider the comments received following the formal advertisement of speed limit changes on the C9, C32, C42 and C155 and to recommend an appropriate way forward.

Consultation

The initial results of the review were disseminated to the relevant town and parish councils who were invited to make comment on the recommendations and were given the opportunity to put forward their case, should they wish to see a different result from that proposed by the review. Following the initial consultation period, a number of the affected town and parish councils, as well as Wiltshire Councillors, commented on the proposals.

Options Considered

To:

- (i) Implement the advertised changes.
- (i) Retain the existing speed restrictions and delete the proposal from the implementation programme.
- (ii) Amend the advertised changes in accordance with the comments made.

Reason for Decision

The proposals have been assessed in accordance with the guidance provided by the Department for Transport, Circular 01/13 'Setting Local Speed Limits'.
