## **MELKSHAM AND MELKSHAM WITHOUT: PROPOSED WAITING RESTRICTIONS**

### **Purpose of Report**

To:

- (i) Consider objections to the advertised proposals for parking controls at various locations in the Melksham and Melksham Without Traffic Regulation Order.
- (ii) Recommend the making of the Traffic Regulation Order with no amendments to the advertised proposals.

### **Consultation**

The Melksham Town Council and Melksham Without Parish Council, where proposals were located, were consulted as part of the advertisement process for the proposals and the recommendations have been discussed with the appropriate Wiltshire Councillors for those areas.

As a result of the public advertisement one letter of representation was received.

This is listed in **Appendix 1** together with a summary of their comments and officer comments on the points raised.

### **Options Considered**

To:

- (i) Implement the proposals as advertised.
- (ii) Not implement the proposals.
- (iii) Implement the proposals with amendments.

### **Reason for Decision**

The comments set out in **Appendix 1** on the objection received indicate that it is considered appropriate to introduce the scheme as advertised, detailed in **Appendix 2**.

**DECISION MADE**

I approve that:

- (i) The restrictions be implemented as advertised, detailed in Appendix 2.
- (ii) The objectors be informed accordingly.
