**CHOPPING KNIFE LANE, MARLBOROUGH ORDER RESTRICTION
OF WAITING, TRAFFIC CALMING, 20MPH SPEED LIMIT**

Purpose of Report

To consider 4 comments and 2 objections in connection with the proposed 20 mph speed limit zone and waiting restrictions on various roads in the vicinity of Chopping Knife Lane , Marlborough (see Appendix 2).

Consultation

Consultations have been undertaken with the Fire Service, Police and Ambulance Service and also with the relevant bus companies, the Town Council, the Local Member. Advertisements have been posted in the local press and notices were posted in prominent positions at the site (see Appendix 1).

Options Considered

To:

- (i) Implement the proposals as advertised.
- (ii) Not implement the proposals.
- (iii) Implement the proposals with amendments.

Reason for Decision

The introduction of a 20 mph speed limit zone on and around various roads in the vicinity of Chopping Knife Lane, and 'no-waiting at any time' restrictions on the junction of Vespasian Road and Chopping Knife Lane will ensure unfettered access for refuse and emergency vehicles.
