# TRAFFIC CALMING FEATURES - ROUNDWAY RISE, CALNE WITHOUT

#### **Purpose of Report**

To consider one objection (requesting an additional speed cushion), two letters of support and one comment in regards to the advertisement of a proposed traffic calming system on Roundway Rise, Calne, comprising a raised traffic table and two speed cushions (see **Appendix 2**).
