HTW 8-19 - WESTBURY ORDER PROPOSED WAITING RESTRICTIONS

Purpose of Report

To:

- (i) Consider objections to the advertised proposals for parking controls at various locations within Westbury Parish Order.
- (ii) Recommend the making of the Traffic Regulation Order (TRO) with minor amendments to the advertised proposal.

Consultation

As part of the town centre parking review the relevant town and parish councils were consulted prior to the advertisement process. The review resulted in seven locations in Westbury being put forward to advertisement. These locations were: The Tynings, Willoughby Close, Primmers Place, Phoenix Rise, The Butts, Arundell Close and Bitham Mill.

During the advertisement period a total of 50 letters of representation have been received in response to the proposals contained within the advertised TRO. Of those 50 letters received, 12 supported the scheme, 36 objected and 2 commented on the proposal.

Details of correspondence can be found in Appendix 1 together with a summary of comments. Officer response to the comments can be found in Appendix 2.

Options Considered

To:

- (i) Implement the proposals as advertised.
- (ii) Not implement the proposals.
- (iii) Implement the proposals with amendments.

Reason for Decision

The comments set out in Appendix 2 on the various objections received indicate that it is considered appropriate to introduce the scheme with minor amendments as shown in Appendix 3.

DECISION MADE

I approve that:

- (i) The restrictions be implemented as advertised, subject to the minor amendments detailed in Appendix 3.
- (ii) The objectors be informed accordingly.

This decision was published on 3rd April 2019 and will come into force on 11th April 2019.
