RESULTS OF THE CONSULTATION AND STATUTORY NOTICES ON THE CLOSURE OF THE SALISBURY HIGH SCHOOL TO ESTABLISH AN ACADEMY ON THE SITE

Purpose of Report

1. The report summarises the results of the public consultation undertaken between December 2009 and January 2010 and the statutory proposals published on 25 February 2010.

Consultation

- 2. Following the public consultation referred to in 1 above the Cabinet Member for Children's Services decided to publish statutory proposals to close Salisbury High School and establish an Academy on the current site from 1 September 2010.
- 3. The report attached to the Cabinet Members decision of 11 February detailed the public consultation process and its outcome.
- 4. The statutory proposals to implement the consultation and close Salisbury High School were published on 25 February 2010. Copies of the proposals are attached. The notices expired on 8 April 2010 and no objections have been received.

Reason for Decision

The establishment of an Academy will bring considerable benefits to the pupils and wider community. All consultation requirements have been met and no objections have been received.

INTENTION TO MAKE DECISION

Following a public consultation and the publication of statutory notices, I give notice that I intend to determine:

- (i) the closure of Salisbury High School on 31 August 2010
- (ii) the establishment of an Academy on the current site of Salisbury High School from 1 September 2010.

This decision will not be made for a period of five days and if you would like to make any representations to me on this issue please do so by the 16th April 2010
