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## **PROPOSAL TO CREATE A RESOURCE BASE AT KIWI PRIMARY SCHOOL, BULFORD**

### **Purpose of Report**

To approve the Council to make a prescribed alteration to Kiwi Primary School, Bulford by creating a resource base (special educational needs provision).

### **Consultation**

It was agreed with Kiwi Primary School to start the statutory four-week consultation period on 6<sup>th</sup> June 2021. During this formal consultation period there were three responses, all in favour of the proposal to create the resource base.

### **Options Considered**

Creating the resource base for the 2021-22 academic year will help meet the identified need for specialist SEN school places in the Bulford and East Wiltshire area. The alternative 'do nothing' would carry the risks identified in this paper.

### **Reason for Decision**

To provide specialist SEN school places for children in the Bulford and East Wiltshire area assessed as needing this provision based on their Education, Health and Care Plan (EHCP).
