STATION HILL, CHIPPENHAM - EXPERIMENTAL LOADING BAY

Purpose of Report

To consider the comments received following the formal advertisement of an experimental loading bay on Station Hill, Chippenham.

Consultation

Consultation has been undertaken with:

- The elected Wiltshire Council Members through the statutory Traffic Regulation Order (TRO) consultation process
- The elected Chippenham Town Council Members for all Wards through the statutory TRO consultation process
- Emergency services through the statutory TRO consultation process
- Members of the public through the statutory TRO consultation process

Options Considered

To:

- (i) Retain the loading bay and make the experimental order permanent.
- (ii) Abandon the proposals and advertise an amended proposal.
- (iii) Abandon the proposal and remove the experimental loading bay.

Reason for Decision

The proposal is intended to improve traffic flow all whilst improving the accessibility to the local shops to aid their businesses.
