Purpose of Report

To consider the comments received following the formal advertisement of a proposed Toucan crossing on the A346 Salisbury Road, Marlborough and to recommend an appropriate way forward.

Consultation

Consultation has been undertaken with:

- The elected Wiltshire Council Member through the statutory TRO consultation process.
- The elected Marlborough Town Council through the statutory TRO consultation process
- Emergency services through the statutory TRO consultation process
- Members of the public through the statutory TRO consultation process

Options Considered

To:

- I. Implement the proposals as advertised.
- II. Abandon the proposals.

Reason for Decision

The provision of a Toucan crossing at this location has been identified as a requirement through the planning process associated with the Marlberg Grange development and subject to public consultation as part of that process. The formal advertisement to which this report relates is for the controlled zone associated with the crossing. Implementation of the controlled zone in accordance with the Road Traffic Regulation Act (1984) ensures

that enforcement of the controlled zone can take place to minimise the potential for conflict arising from vehicles stopping to park or load/unload within the extents of the crossing.
