## **PROPOSED PUFFIN CROSSING - WYNSOME STREET, SOUTHWICK**

### **Purpose of Report**

To consider the objections received following the formal advertisement of a PUFFIN Crossing (Pedestrian User Friendly Intelligent) at Wynsome Street, Southwick.

### **Consultation**

Consultations (at pre-consultation and full consultation stage) have been undertaken with the Fire, Police and Ambulance Services and also with the relevant bus companies. The Parish Councils have been consulted. Correspondence has been received and acknowledged from the local Wiltshire Council Member. Advertisements have been posted in the local press and notices erected in prominent positions close to the proposed crossing location on site (see **Appendix 1**).

### **Options Considered**

To:

- (i) Implement the proposal as advertised.
- (ii) Not implement the proposal.
- (iii) Implement the proposal with amendments.

### **Reason for Decision**

To provide improved crossing provision for pedestrians using Wynsome Street, Southwick.
