Purpose of Report

To consider the objections received following the formal advertisement of a PUFFIN Crossing (Pedestrian User Friendly Intelligent) at Wynsome Street, Southwick.

Consultation

Consultations (at pre-consultation and full consultation stage) have been undertaken with the Fire, Police and Ambulance Services and also with the relevant bus companies. The Parish Councils have been consulted. Correspondence has been received and acknowledged from the local Wiltshire Council Member.
