PROPOSED WAITING RESTRICTIONS IN KINGSLAND ROAD AREA,
SALISBURY

Purpose of Report

To:

- (i) Consider objections to the proposed introduction of waiting restrictions at various locations in the vicinity of Kingsland Road, Salisbury.
- (ii) Recommend the making of the Traffic Regulation Order (TRO) as advertised.

Options Considered

To:

- (i) Implement the proposals as advertised.
- (ii) Abandon the proposals.
- (iii) Implement the proposals with minor amendments.

Reason for Decision

It is felt that the Council's proposals offer a balanced approach between addressing problems accessing Sarum St. Paul's School and maximising the amount of parking available in the context of the Council meeting its statutory duty to maintain a right of passage along the public highway.
