#### **Project Summary:**

Following feedback from Wiltshire Council's youth justice team, several concerns were raised about young people in the community area. Some of whom are persistent offenders, and others who are part of a cohort of young people involved in minor ASB. Concerns around county lines and other exploitation have been raised but are unconfirmed. This project would provide detatched youth work with an aim of encouraging these young people to re-engage with services, school and activities.
