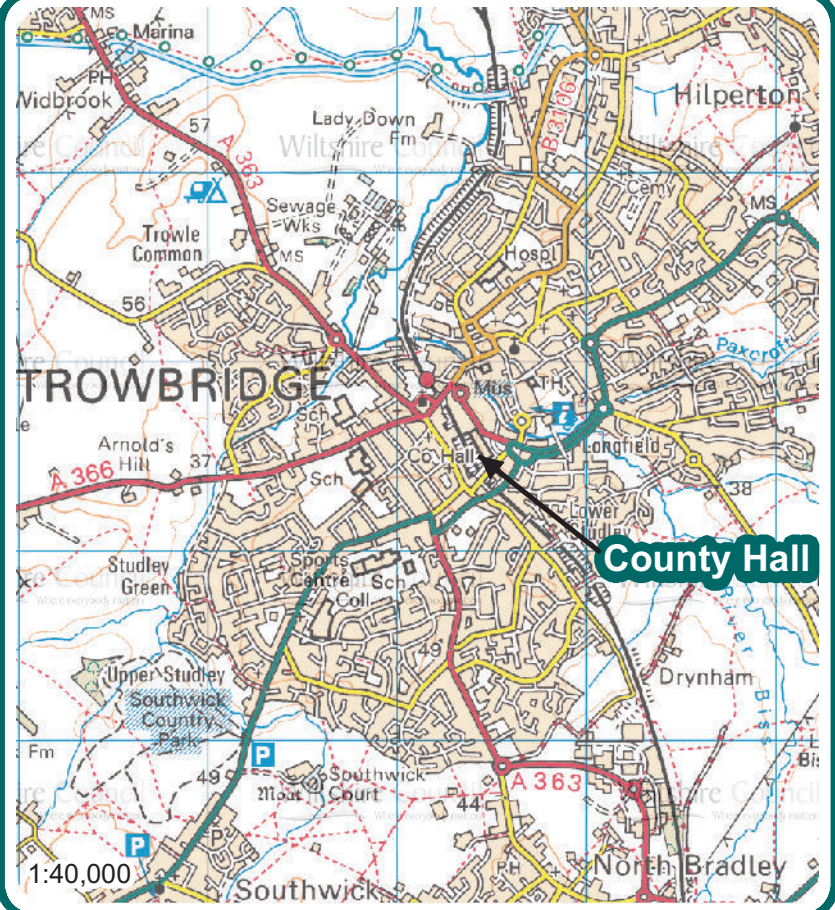
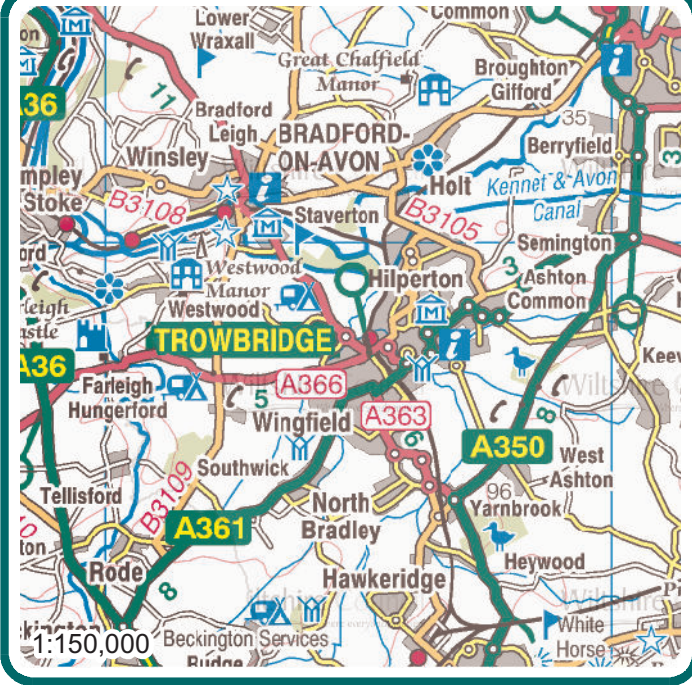

County Hall - location map

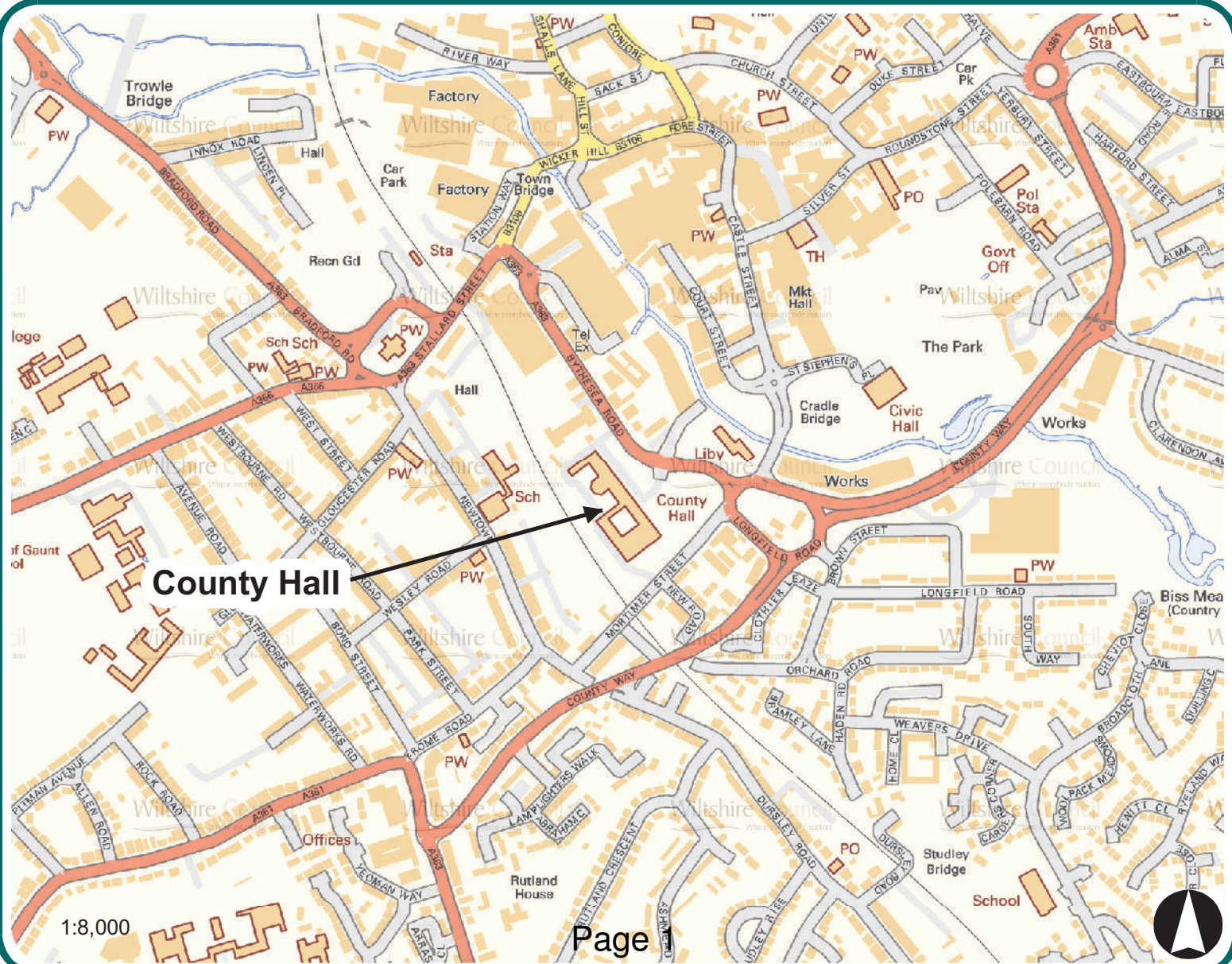
