## **Background**

As part of ongoing engagement with communities and wider stakeholders, on February 19<sup>th</sup> 2014, the Defence Infrastructure Organisation (DIO) launched a six-week consultation on the draft Salisbury Plain Masterplan. This set out proposed developments to accommodate the extra personnel and their families who are due to move to Wiltshire over the next five years as part of the Army Basing Programme. The consultation closed on April 1<sup>st</sup>. Feedback received through the consultation is helping to shape the final Masterplan which will identify where development may take place.

The plans to bring some 4,300 service personnel to the Salisbury Plain area between this summer and 2019 were announced by the Ministry of Defence (MOD) in March 2013. They form part of the Regular Army Basing Plan which details the future for the Army as it restructures and moves back to the UK from Germany.

This public meeting is aimed at the Amesbury, Tidworth, Warminster, Salisbury and Pewsey community areas and is being hosted by Tidworth Area Board. The aim of the meeting is to ensure local communities can learn more about MOD's latest proposals. There will be information on the proposed development and further details on how people will be able to comment.
