

WEST WILTSHIRE PARISHES: PROPOSED WAITING RESTRICTIONS

COMMENTS FROM UNITARY MEMBERS AND PARISH COUNCILS

Atworth

At a recent Council meeting, members of Atworth Parish Council asked if Councillor Thompson could be made aware that they wish to override any objections and fully recommend the implementation of road markings to deter those that park in a selfish manner.

Hilperton

Hilperton Parish Council fully supports these proposals.

The Mead Primary School supports proposals on Hackett Place, so that access is maintained especially for emergency vehicles.

Wiltshire Councillor Ernie Clark commented that he thought the lining proposals in Hackett Place were too extensive and hoped that a balance could be achieved, whilst still preventing obstruction particularly at school drop off and pick up times.

Also that in the time it has taken to complete the report due to unforeseen capacity issues, the Hilperton Relief Road has been completed and therefore questions the need to implement some of the restrictions in the main village.

Holt

Holt Parish Council had been concerned about parking causing access difficulties for residents and others and fully supports these proposals.

North Bradley

North Bradley Parish Council and Wiltshire Council's Economic Development Team (to whom local businesses approached requesting restrictions) are in full support of these proposals.

Staverton

Staverton Parish Council and Wiltshire Councillor Trevor Carbin have been campaigning for restrictions on the estate for a number of years and fully support these proposals.

Winsley

Winsley Parish Council fully supports the proposals to deter inconsiderate drivers that park in a way that regularly obstructs the bus service, serving the residents of the village.
