

STATUTORY NOTICE

St Michael's Primary School, Figcheldean

Relocation and expansion of Church of England Voluntary Controlled Primary School

Notice is given in accordance with section 19(1) of the Education and Inspections Act 2006, and the School Organisation (Prescribed Alterations to Maintained Schools) (England) Regulations 2013, that the Governing Body of St Michael's Primary School, Figcheldean together with the Salisbury Diocesan Board of Education intend to relocate and expand a Church of England Voluntary Controlled Primary school **which will operate as a single primary school on a site at The Packway, Larkhill, Wiltshire.**

The relocated primary school will have the same admissions policy and the published admissions number will rise from 17 to 30 in September 2018 and to 60 in September 2019. Pupils attending St Michael's School at the current location in Figcheldean would automatically transfer to the new site. The expansion is necessary due to the construction of 444 service family homes arising from the Army Basing Masterplan.

With effect from 1 September 2018, St Michael's CEVC Primary School will relocate to a new building to be constructed at The Packway, Larkhill, Wiltshire.

These proposals will have a modest impact on transport due to the distance of the new site from some homes in the Figcheldean parish.
