TRAFFIC CALMING FEATURE - BRATTON ROAD, WEST ASHTON

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Wiltshire Council in exercise of its powers under Section 90A of the Highways Act 1980 proposes in **Bratton Road, West Ashton** the installation of a Raised Traffic Table of full carriageway width at a point 56 metres south of its junction with East Town Road and Speed Cushions at a point 45 metres south east of its junction with Orchard Close as indicated on the plan below. The traffic calming features will have a maximum height of 75 millimetres with a maximum ramp gradient of 1 in 13 and will form a method of reducing the speed of vehicles crossing in the interests of road safety.

A copy of the plan showing the location of the traffic calming feature may be inspected at the offices of Wiltshire Council, County Hall, Bythesea Road, Trowbridge during normal office hours.
