The town council has an ongoing priority to supply land for sports pitches. As a well run local football club we will be able to make full use of facilities the council can provide. There will be mutual cooperation and recognition.

How did you discover there was a need for your project and how will your project benefit your local community?

The previous local football club was at the end of it's life. The remaining members relaunched the club with a new name, new committee and new goals. The success of the club is highlighted by the increase in membership. However, our success has almost overrun our ability to finance the teams. This is one reason we need to provide a unified approach to our match playing as we need to encourage local business to support us by donation or sponsorship.

Any other information about your project.

Our club is run for the local community by members of the community. Although all our team coaches and managers are volunteers they are all trained to FA standards, have relevant first aid training and CRB checks. The committee is run by parents who mostly work and have families. The football club has an outreach project and undertook basic football training at Clarendon School last year. This year we hope to perform the same service for Zouch School. Our club is now so succesful we have a 'Soccer School' for youngsters too young to play in under 7's games ie from 5 to 7 years old. This Soccer School is now also full and we are having to contemplate another 'team' for those youngsters with developing skills but not yet match ready. As our older children grow we can forsee having more adult teams to run and indeed have already placed a five year plan with the Football Association. Tidworth Royals FC is here to stay and looks forward to maintaing our role in the community.
