As a club we are totally self funded, this is the first time we have ever applied for a grant. But we have exhausted the sponsorship route and were not sure what else to do. We have 35 member and 3 teams playing in the locally moonraker league. we are the third biggest club in the county behind devizes and chippenham. Our A team play in the premier division and our B and C teams play in division 2. We are a competitive club but at the same time very welcoming to new member and all abilities, this year alone we have had 5 new people join, some of them news mums that want to lose weight and get fit, but more importantly get more confident. We are friendly and welcoming. We are a well set up club with an active committee and try to support local initiatives as much as possible.

Alternatively next summer our annual netball communitiy tournament we will have to raises funds for the club rather than the extra netball court or local charities which would be a real shame.

Buying club kit itself will not make a massive difference to the communitiy, but having well set up rural /local run sports club (espically for women due to the drop off in participation rates is hugely important for the health and well being of the community. With the government agendas around adult participant in sports, wiltshire wanting to be the Healthiest county and the nation needing to changing behaviours and leading a healthier lifestyles, we believe that we are ticking all the boxes.
