Numbers 5768, 5806, 5811 were all rejected as exceeding the available budget for this scheme. 5805 was precluded from the scheme as it is a bridleway. 5813 needed further clarification that would not be possible to follow up given the deadlines in place for this scheme. It was felt that the remaining requests, 5799 at Hilmarton and 5812 at William Street, Calne. Should Sould be taken forward for further action.
