Each club will receive 3 hours of delivery between now and the end of March 2018. Innov8 Sportz CIC will schedule session delivery with the individual youth clubs thorough contacts provided by Tom Bray.

The aim of the sessions is to introduce alternative sports to the youth club members. These sports maybe activities that members have not previously been aware of, this gives them the opportunity to learn new skills and participate on a level playing field with their peers. Sessions will be focused on participation through enjoyment and the sports that will be provided include: Tchoukball, Dodgeball, Handball, Ultimate Frisbee, GA GA Ball and Y-Ball. Innov8 Sportz CIC will provide 2 qualified sports coaches or each session, these coaches hold all relevant DBS checks and in-date safeguarding and First aid qualifications.
