## How did you discover there was a need for your project and how will your project benefit your local community?

We invited the Fire Safety Inspector to visit to ascertain that we were fully protected in the event of a fire and to ensure that we fulfilled our obligations as detailed in "Regulatory Reform (Fire Safety) order 2005 in order to ensure that the Hall remains open & safe for public use. We were advised that some additional alarm systems were required and improvement to fire protection of the fabric and escape routes.

With the upgrading advised by the Fire Safety Inspector we shall ensure that all who use the Hall are protected in the case of fire to the best of our abilities and as required by law.

Three elderly people from Swindon & one from Ashton Keynes as well as the elderly from Cricklade attend the Open Door Club and we need to have a safe venue for this client group and all our groups of users. All users shall be reassured that the additional fire protection allows them to feel as safe and as protected as possible.

## Any other information about your project.

To reduce costs our volunteers will paint the fire doors when they are installed.

We are in the process of preparing for an visit by the Hallmark Scheme auditors in the next 3 months. This scheme promotes & rewards good practice by raising management standards particularly in relation to procedures and policies and should assure potential funders that we are managing the Hall in a professional manner.
