Mrs Suzanna Taverner	A resident who uses the car park for personal use and also used by visitors to their property. Would find it difficult to cope with a three hour limit on the car park.	Council response – the car parks primary function is to provide parking for members of the leisure centre; it is not intended for use by local residents. All users of the car park would need to comply with the maximum stay applied to the car park.
Mrs Fiona McLaughlan	Would it be possible for membership persons to have a car permit sticker or similar to put into their cars. As membership holders are sometimes needing more than 3 hours for the exercise they wish to do, also a 3 hour no return could be a problem for someone wanting to do the gym or swim and then return an hour later to do a class or similar. I can understanding the problem with people not using the centre parking, but I do think some prevision should be made for the hard core exercise people (Membership holders) I am not the only one to feel this to be a problem. I had a problem even finding how to send this to you, as nothing is put up to inform people in the actual leisure centre.
