Air quality management areas in Wiltshire

Local authorities have to designate an air quality management area (AQMA) where the prescribed Air Quality Objectives are not likely to be met by or at any point beyond the relevant deadline.

Wiltshire currently has eight AQMAs (for exceedences of the annual average of nitrogen dioxide) locations are shown on the maps below:



- Calne


Map of AQMAs in Wiltshire






