

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

1. THE COUNTY OF WILTSHIRE (A4 NEW ROAD, STUDLEY, CALNE WITHOUT) (50MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2018

2. PEDESTRIAN CROSSING – A4 NEW ROAD, STUDLEY, CALNE WITHOUT

Wiltshire Council proposes under the above Orders to introduce a 50mph speed limit and the installation of a “TOUCAN” Crossing (an un-segregated crossing for pedestrians and cyclists) on **A4 New Road, Studley, Calne Without** as indicated on the plan below.

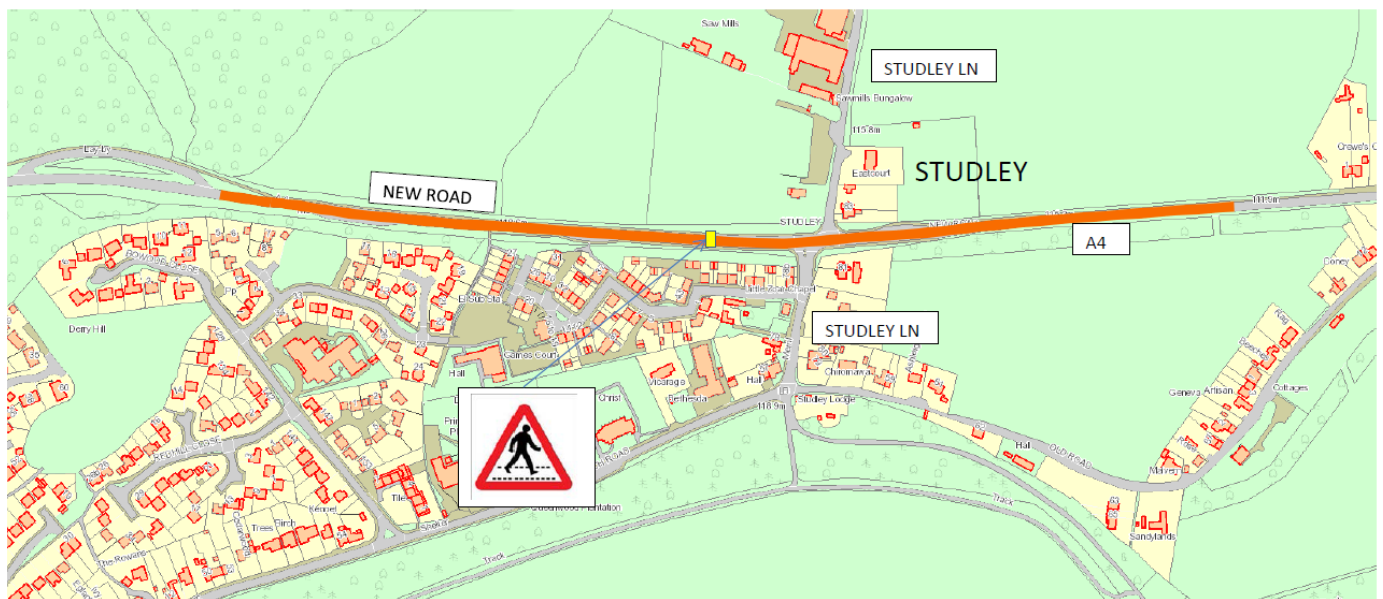
