However, Another 75mm Speed Cushion is needed just north of this, where Roundway rise Meets Cherhill way, just before the bends !!. The straight section of road, just before the S Bends is dangerous, with cars accelerating into the straight from both ends. There are 14 Houses with Access, including a new junction just being built, onto this small straight section of road, most have to reverse out of the drive and literally risk there lives. Another 75mm Speed Cushion is needed to slow the traffic somewhere near No's 4 or 6 Cherhill way, to complement and make this scheme work fully. I agree that the proposal is good but object to the proposal overall. I would be in agreeance if further measures are provided for another 75mm Speed Cushion on Cherhill way, Somewhere outside No 4 or 6, Just before the bends (Adjoining Roundway rise), As stated in my previous response, was provided.
