Please find my comments and observations reference in respect to the Wiltshire Housing Site Allocations Plan Examination.

The reason for my further correspondence on the matter is that after I had attended the West Tisbury PC meeting held on 1 November 2018, it was agreed after a long discussion at the public session at the start of the meeting that the Parish Council's proposal to add the Settlement Boundary line was in the wrong place and their preferred Boundary line was now the Red line as shown on the Settlement Boundary Map Dated June 2017. Since that meeting I now understand that WTPC have written to WCC for clarification of the Settlement Boundary Area and have not put forward the agreed amendment that was discussed and agreed at the 1 November 2018 meeting.

Location of proposed changes.

The area which encompasses the proposed settlement boundary Westgate & 94 Mount Pleasant was originally part of the Pyt House Estate which was sold off in the early 1970s. This does not change the fact that these two areas still back directly onto the original field to the East of the area which is still used as a livestock field and open countryside. The criteria for calculating whether such areas should or could be included in the revised Settlement Plan quite openly states that in Para 5.2 & 8.2 that these are areas that have been excluded.

Therefore it seems to me that the outline area of the proposed change (outlined in Red on the Plan) should be upheld and no change to this is acceptable.
