- £50 for the first permit and £70 for the second permit (at the same address) in limited waiting zones where permit holders are exempt from the time limit; and
- o £80 for the first permit and £100 for the second permit (at the same address) in residents' only zones.
- The number of permits available to households may be limited dependent on available kerb space and opportunity for off road parking;
- Having a permit would not guarantee a space outside your house or within the zone;
- Schemes can reduce the amount of parking available as additional controls (yellow lines) may be required to protect junctions, access or visibility;
- Enforcement of the area will be undertaken;
- Please note that consideration of any scheme for progression will be dependent, on a minimum of 50% of responses from households within a zone.
