It is already extremely difficult for me to park near my house, particularly between 08.30 and 18.00. I have a young son and would like to be able to park near my house. Many people park on the stretch in front of my house and the surrounding area who don't live here. They are all attending either the Hathaway medical centre or Lloyds pharmacy and have no regard for local residents. There also a number of people who use this area to park their cars who work at Lloyds pharmacy. Ample parking provision or parking strategies should have been applied to those areas and not finding the answer in penalising local residents.
