## SCHOOL TERMS AND HOLIDAYS 2012/13

## Purpose

1. The purpose of this item is:
i) to report the findings of the consultation regarding proposed school term and holiday dates for 2012/13.
ii) to confirm JCC's support for the recommended school term and holiday dates for Wiltshire's Community, Voluntary Controlled and Community Special Schools for the school year 2012/13.

## School Term \& Holiday Dates - 2012/13

2. In line with the recommendation of the County Secretaries at its meeting in November 2010 a variety of interested parties including schools, neighbouring authorities, diocese plus others have been consulted on proposed term dates for 2012/13 (Appendix 1).
3. Appendix 2 details comments received as a result of this consultation.
4. A number of our neighbouring authorities have now either completed or are in the process of consulting on their own school term dates for 2012/13. The majority of our neighbours to the south west have consulted on dates similar, if not identical, to Wiltshire's proposal.

## Proposal

5. JCC is invited to consider the responses to the consultation on the proposed school term \& holiday dates for 2012/13 and decide whether to confirm its support for the dates detailed in Option 2.
