How did you discover there was a need for your project and how will your project benefit your local community?

Great Bedwyn Playgroup and Toddlers is a highly regarded education provider that is indispensible to local parents and their pre-school children. It has been established for 43 years, and during those years has become a real focal point for the village community. The governments Early Years Foundation Stage statutory framework clearly state that, "Providers must ensure that there is a balance of adult-led or child-initiated activities, delivered through indoor and outdoor play". We therefore have a specific legal requirement for children to play outdoors. Athough the playgroup has an outdoor play area, the addition of a construction set will provide endless opportunities for imaginary play and help with maths, literacy and ICT development. During the summer months this outdoor area becomes a real sun trap and it is a constant challenge to keep children adequately protected from the sun. In readiness for the warmer months we desperately want to improve our sun protection and the gazebo and canopy would allow us to adequately cover our paved and grassy area, allowing our children to play safely al I year. The local parish council will be informed about the project at their next meeting in April. In the meantime, the council has been informally notified of our community area board grant application.

We have been advised of the necessity of holding a term's worth of running costs as our reserve funds - this is the reason for accumulating £15,000 in the fund.

The majority of playgroup children move on to attending the village school. Thus the playgroup forms a vital link for the children and helps to promote their inclusion into the community at an early age whilst promoting good community relations between future school parents.
