Finger Posts

Every parish has them!



The Members of South West Wiltshire Area Board recognise the contribution of finger posts to the AONB and our communities.

In 2021-2022 the Board is considering making funds available to each Parish Council which would like to upgrade a finger post due to damage or disrepair.

The Area Board will use community funds to subsidise up to 50% (to a maximum of £500) of the total cost of each post. 2 posts per financial year per parish council is permitted.

The work must be carried out to the Wiltshire Council specification, a detailed work plan & target timeline must be submitted with each grant application, including a before photograph, invoices and a photograph of the new post in place. Timber is to be from renewable sources, letters & figures on the finger post will be standard and Wiltshire Council will point parishes towards a suitable source. No changes of names on the finger posts will be countenanced (any changes etc need Gazetting to comply with regulations)
