We need motorists to be more aware that they are entering village communities. Creating a safer environment for all parishioners (for at least 700 people all ages). Following research and the positive experience of similar communities we want to introduce "white gates" at the entrances to both villages at or close to the existing 40 mph signs. Provide a sense of well-being for all road users including pedestrians, cyclists and horse-riders and will enable motorists safer access through the villages. This will make it easier for parishioners to cross the road to the bus stops at Hilmarton and Goatacre. It will also benefit those crossing the road to attend public places/events to the south and north of the A3102 at Hilmarton and Goatacre; Hilmarton School, Community Room ( Playgroup, Toddler Group, Phoenix Club, Parish Meetings), Phone Box Museum, St. Laurence Church (Bell-ringers, weddings, christenings funerals), Hilmarton Chapel (Childrens Group, Ladies Fellowship, Smile Group), Post Office, Parish Village Hall (village cinema, line dancing, gardening club), The Duke Hotel, Goatacre Cricket Club, Goatacre Village Hall, (Cinema, over 60's lunch club) Goatacre Nursing Home. Private Functions also take place at many of these venues. Regular deliveries of oil, food ,post and parcels increasing. Livestock also move across A3102 at western end of Parish.

HAGGIS was set up as a result of many parishioners expressing concern at the dangers of crossing the A3012. We have received letters from parishioners and tourists.

We organised a petition where there was overwhelming support to improve safety.

A fatal road accident occurred at Hilmarton soon after HAGGIS was set up.

We carried out a 12 hour traffic survey based on Wiltshire Council guidelines 7<sup>th</sup> October 2008.

During a 15 minute period in Hilmarton there were 308 traffic movements (A 2009 survey at Lyneham shows a greater increase in traffic volume).

Some elderly pedestrians shop in Wootton Bassett instead of Calne to avoid crossing the road with heavy shopping.

Some travel to Calne to catch bus back to Swindon to avoid crossing road.

All HAGGIS meetings are reported to Parish Council by Minutes and supported by them.

We will know it is making a difference by regular dialogue with parishioners and more questionnaires.

People with free bus passes will travel more by public transport.

People from outside the village leave cars close to the bus stops to commute to places of work by bus.
