We wanted to provide you with an update on the FUEL Programme, which will be supporting eligible families during the Christmas holidays.

Background

Our Holiday Activity and Food programme, FUEL (Food, Unity, Energy and Laughter) is funded by the Department for Education and provides children who are eligible for benefits-related free school meals with free access to activity, food and nutritional education during school holidays.

Following a challenging summer, which saw our main provider cease trading, Wiltshire Council worked with a range of organisations to ensure families didn't miss out. More than 1,300 young people took part in the summer programme and nearly 10,000 nutritious meals were provided. A total of 16 organisations delivered 27 camps during the summer programme, providing activities throughout the county. A variety of activities were provided including multi-sports, farmyard experiences, gymnastics, outdoor learning, performing arts and photography.

Christmas 2023 programme

We are delighted to be working with most of the activity providers from the summer and will be offering 19 activity camps during the Christmas holidays, including two specifically for children with SEND.

Booking a place

Unlike the summer, which saw families having to email different providers to book a place, requests for activities can now be made and managed in one place, using our Citizen ID system.

Families can register for Citizen ID by following this link <u>https://www.wiltshire.gov.uk/login</u>. It will also be possible to register for Citizen ID at the same time as making requests for places on activities.

If people already have a Citizen ID account, which is used by a variety of council services, then they can simply use their existing log-in details. This method ensures people can book onto the programme and manage their bookings much more simply.

The booking system is now open and will remain so until 8 December 2023.
