Table 3.1: Usual Mode of Travel











Table 3.4: Mobility





Table 4.1: Spending Split

Table 4.3: Priority: Chippenham Cycle Routes












Table 5.4: Priority: Devizes Walking Routes









Route 2 – Canal Rd to Trinity Junction
