



What is a carers assessment?



Carers Assessments – Legal Rights

The Care Act 2014 came into effect in April 2015 and replaced most previous laws regarding both carers and people being cared for.

Under the Care Act, you are entitled to a carer's assessment where you appear to have needs for support.

You will be entitled to this support if you meet the national eligibility criteria.





Support for Parent Carers





Parent Carers - Carers Assessment

Any parent carer can receive a support call from Carers Together Wiltshire and have an 'assessment'

If their child is **over 18yrs** they can have a **statutory carers assessment**, which may result in a funded service, if eligible.

If their child is **under 18yrs** we have developed what we call a '**parent carer needs assessment**' which is designed to help the carer to access unfunded support.
