Dear Mr Poole

I am writing further to the meeting held with David Bennett and I at Jax on 16th August 2011. At that meeting we discussed a number of concerns raised by patrol and investigating officers in relation to the management of Jax Chippenham.

To ensure clarity and provide an audit please find below a brief summary of the records police currently hold in relation to the licensing aspect of the premises.

#### CCTV

On the 29th of October 2010, the police licensing officer met with your business partners David Rowe and Philip Alnatt. You were not available to attend this meeting but it is understood that you were fully appraised of the meeting content and copied in on the action plan produced by Jax management on the 30th of October 2010.

During the meeting a number of concerns relating to the availability of CCTV were discussed.

As a result of the meeting Mr Allnatt forwarded an action plan to police which detailed the steps to be taken by the premises to ensure that the system was fully functioning, retaining images for at least 30 days and that staff at the premises would have instruction on how to access the images if required by police.

On the 22<sup>nd</sup> of May 2011, police received a complaint of assault. This allegedly took place at Jax, the suspect being an off duty door supervisor. CCTV images were requested and after Jax management failed to produce the CCTV requested, the police seized the hard drive for examination. Enquiries are still on going in relation to this matter.

On the 16<sup>th</sup> of July, a male sustained injuries which required hospital treatment. The suspect in this instance being a member of Jax door staff. CCTV images were requested and police were told that the camera covering the location was unplugged.

On the 16<sup>th</sup> of July 2011, a male was arrested for assault on a female, CCTV images were requested by police, and on this occasion investigating officers were advised that the images had been 'taped over'.

On the 31<sup>st</sup> of July 2011, police received a complaint of an assault which resulted in a minor injury which was treated by a paramedic; several requests were made to the premises for CCTV images. I understand that this evidence has now been lost as the current system retains images for a limited period of time.

### Door supervision

On the 30<sup>th</sup> of July 2011, officers recorded a number of licensed premises checks at all the Chippenham premises. A was found to be working as a door supervisor at Jax whilst his Security Industry Authority was suspended.

A number of concerns have been raised in relation to the behaviour of the Head Doorman at Jax, it is understood that you have this matter in hand.

## Record keeping

You have provided the incident records and door supervisors signing in sheets from the 3<sup>rd</sup> of June 2011. An assessment has been carried out of the records; they are incomplete and/or inaccurate. Incidents which have resulted in criminal investigations are not recorded and the record of door supervisors employed at the premises is inaccurate.

At the time of our meeting, in relation to the premises age verification policy, training records and records of authorisation, these documents were not available for inspection.

#### Violent crime

On the 25<sup>th</sup> of May 2011 police and council licensing officers met with you to discuss a number of issues including the number of incidents that had been reported to police.

A further analysis of the data held by police has been carried out, and has found that there is an increase in the number of violent crimes which have been recorded as occurring on the premises or in the immediate vicinity during July 2011 when compared with data available from April, May and June of 2011.

It is accepted that at present this may be due to a number of different factors. However please be aware that police will continue to monitor the level of incidents in line with our tasking process, and where it is found that high levels of intoxication and/or poor management practices are found to be contributory factors, further action may be considered.

Police have increasing concerns in relation to the premises known as Jax and its management's commitment to the licensing objectives.

In an effort to address these concerns, further input appears to be necessary. With that in mind there is a requirement for further discussion with police and the development of an action plan to try and address the problems.

Please make contact with the Wiltshire Police Licensing Department as a priority to determine a suitable date for the meeting.

Re: Licensing Act 2003 - Premises Licence LN/0007 Formal Warning

I am writing further to the meeting held at Jax Landing on 26<sup>th</sup> May 2011. Present at the meeting were the following:

David Poole, Designated Premises Supervisor Jackie Gallimore, Police Licensing Officer Paul Reid, Manager Linda Holland, Senior Licensing Officer, Wiltshire Council.

The meeting was called to discuss the progress made by yourself in regard to your record keeping and management systems (policies and procedures) since our last meeting on 5<sup>th</sup> April 2011, and for Wiltshire Police to outline their concerns regarding capacity limits for the premises and the potential problems linked to overcrowding.

I was disappointed to note that there had been little if no improvement in most of the basic requirements.

- 1. No staff training records and no training programme for staff on alcohol licensing requirements were in prace.
- 2. No Age Verification Policy (a mandatory condition on your Premises Licence) was in place.
- 3. A Refusal Book was in place, but records were incomplete with no signature, date or time.
- 4. An Incident Book was in place, but records were incomplete with more details required. The signature of the person completing the record must be completed after each entry.
- 5. A drugs box was in place, but no procedure or policy regarding this was provided.
- 6. No Risk Assessments were available for inspection, including a Fire Risk Assessment.
- 7. No Management Plan was in place. This is to include a chain of command and responsibilities.
- 8. Written authorisation is to be available and up to date.

As discussed at the meeting, it is for the Licence Holder to demonstrate that they are meeting their obligations under the four Licensing Objectives and these matters must be addressed as a matter of urgency.

I plan to re-visit the premises on Wednesday 14<sup>th</sup> June 2011, at 2pm to inspect the documentation.

The penalty for conviction for offences under the Licensing Act 2003 is up to £20,000, up to 6 months imprisonment or both.
