Important: Please do not type/write	The club was started over 10years ago after groups of young people were causing vandalism and other anti-social behaviour in the village. A public meeting was called to discuss the escalating problem and from there a small group of volunteers, led by a Parish Councillor, formed BGHYP and the ASGYPH Volunteers. Theses groups then set up the Youth Club. The club has improved relationships between young people and the older residents and has lowered anti-social behaviour. Complaints to the Parish Council about young people are now very rare and much less is spent on
