	The 2012 Festival will culminate, on Tuesday 22 nd May, in a once in-a-lifetime Olympic Torch Relay through the town followed by a planned Reception for the Torch Bearers, together with other activities and entertainments during the afternoon and evening.

	BOACAN is working alongside The Town Council in leading the organisation of the event. The surrounding Parish Councils, the Sports Clubs, the Chamber of Commerce, the TIC, the Music Centre, Arts and Craft groups, Schools and a variety of other community groups and organisations will all be invited to play a part in the overall organisation.		
	The young local Olympic hopefuls that took part in the Torch Relay Photo Shoot in November (there is a photo on the Wiltshire Council Home Page) will also be involved, together with other sports celebrities.		
	We are aiming for the whole Festival and in particular the Torch Relay Event ,to leave a lasting legacy and inspire the next generation in our community area.		
	There is a huge potential benefit for businesses, involvement of schools, sports clubs, and a wide variety of groups to showcase themselves.		
	There will be full BBC and press coverage for the Torch Relay, with local, national and International media output.

Any other information about your project. There were previously Community Area Sports Festivals in 2010 and 2011, increasing in scope each year. That for 2012, besides coinciding with Olympic Year, will have even more variety and activity and involvement, and will have four particular differences from before:

- 1. The first day, May 13th, will be designed to encourage greater knowledge and understanding of disabled and disability sports and activities.
- 2. The intention is to incorporate some less serious and more fun-giving "community games" as are being used in other parts of the country, and particularly to invite all the parishes to become closely involved in such types of event.
- 3. The final day, May 22nd, will see the Olympic Torch procession through Bradford on Avon, as a once-in-a-lifetime experience for all those in the Community Area both to witness it and to be involved in the communal and community celebrations associated with it.
- 4. Overall, a greater involvement of, and emphasis on, a variety of complementary holistic therapies and other aids to the general well-being and health of individuals.
