From the start we have involved local people -producing Newsletters and getting residents to complete a questionnaire regarding their preferences for the park. We have liased at all times with the town counciland NWDC, and we have publicised the councils' support and help via the local press. This park has acted as a catalyst for other play areas in Malmesbury and for other residents to take a lead in working towards recreational facilities in their own areas. Our initial questionnaire demonstrated the wish for a basketball facility and we are now hopefully in a position to provide one. The Aerial Runwaywill provide an additional piece of equipment suitable for all ages and abilities-especially for older children/teenagers. Tha one at the other end of town has already proven itself a success.
