- 2. At its meeting on 1 November 2011, the Marlborough Area Board earmarked £12,000 from its budget, for a fund to be made available for Parish Councils who wish to apply for financial assistance to stage celebrations/events to mark the Queen's Diamond Jubilee and/or the 2012 London Olympics.
- 3. Two applications to this fund have been received from Marlborough Town Council.
- 4. It is not possible to apply to the Standards Committee for dispensations, as this requires *more than* 50% of Councillors on a committee to have an interest.
