

### ANNEX 1 - MANDATORY CONDITIONS

#### **Door Supervision**

Individuals who are present to guard against a, b or c must be licensed by the Security Industry Authority:

- a. Unauthorised access or occupation (eg through door supervision)
- b. Outbreaks of disorder
- c. Damage

#### Supply of Alcohol

Where this Licence authorises the supply of alcohol:

No supply of alcohol may be made under this licence:

- a. At a time when there is no Designated Premises Supervisor in respect of it
- b. At a time when the Designated Premises Supervisor does not hold a Personal Licence or his Personal Licence is suspended"

Every retail sale or supply of alcohol made under this licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a Personal Licence.

#### **Exhibition of Films**

Where this Licence authorises the exhibition of films:

The admission of children under the age of 18 to film exhibitions permitted under the terms of this licence shall be restricted in accordance with any recommendations made:

a. By the British Board of Film Classification (BBFC,) where the film has been classified by that Board By the Licensing Authority where no classification certificate has been granted by the BBFC or, where the Licensing Authority has notified the licence holder that section 20 (3) (b) (74 (3) (b) for clubs) of the Licensing Act 2003 applies to the film.

### **ANNEX 2A - CONVERTED CONDITIONS**

- The restrictions relating to the permitted hours for the sale and supply of alcohol do not prohibit:
- a. The taking of the alcohol from the premises, (unless the alcohol is supplied or taken in an open vessel,) during the first twenty minutes after the above hours
- The ordering of alcohol to be consumed off the premises, or the despatch by the vendor of the alcohol so ordered
- c. The sale of alcohol to a trader or club for the purposes of the trade or club
- d. The sale or supply of alcohol to any canteen or mess, being a canteen in which the sale or supply of alcohol is carried out under the authority of the Secretary of State or an authorised mess of members of Her Majesty's naval, military or air forces.
- Alcohol shall not be sold in an open container or be consumed in, the licensed premises.
