

ROYAL WOOTTON BASSETT AND CRICKLADE COMMUNITY AREA: PROGRESS ON COMMUNITY LED PLANNING MARCH 2012

1.0 Purpose of report

1.1 The purpose of this report is to give an update on the progress of the community led planning (CLP) groups across the Royal Wootton Bassett and Cricklade Community Area. It also highlights discussions underway to develop a simple framework to enable the groups to feed their information into work to produce an eventual replacement for the current 2005-2015 Community Plan.

2.0 Update on progress

2.1 Two groups have now completed or updated their Community Led Plan (Broad Town and Lydiard Millicent) and seven are actively working towards a plan. A further three Parishes are not currently involved in the process.

3.0 Using the information to inform a revised Community Plan

- 3.1 Community First met recently with Cllr Peter Doyle and Cllr Peter Colmer to consider how the findings from the CLP groups will be fed into work to revise the Community Plan (see Figure 3) and the development of the Neighbourhood Plan Frontrunner.
- 3.2 It was agreed that, as a first step, a simple table was needed indicating the respective stages each group is currently at, together with an indication on timescales for the next stages of the process. This would encourage the groups to share experiences and help the Board to understand when the CLP groups would be able to begin to feed into work on the two community area plans. This will be developed and updated as each group develops their individual programmes of work.
- 3.3 Community First will work with the Board over the coming months to help devise a simple framework by which the issues identified by each group can be collated and fed into both processes and by which the community led planning groups can help influence priorities for action.


